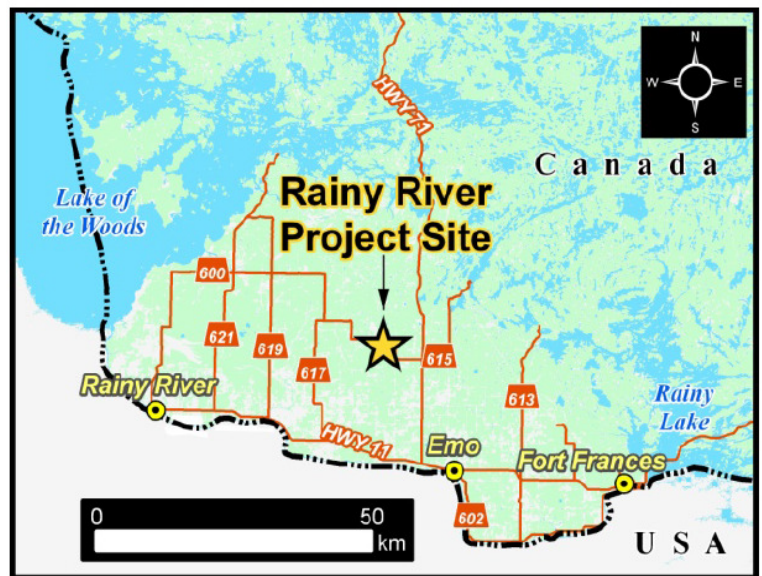
NOTICE OF COMPLETE APPLICATION AND STATUTORY PUBLIC MEETING AND COUNCIL MEETING FOR A PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Township of Chapple will hold a statutory public meeting of the Planning Advisory Committee followed by a Council Meeting on **February 10, 2015, at 9:00 a.m.** in the Council Chambers at 54 Barwick Road, Barwick, ON, P0W 1A0 to gather public input regarding a proposed Zoning By-law Amendment under Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O 1990, c. P. 13, as amended.

APPLICANT: New Gold Inc.

LOCATION: Intersection of Highway 71 and Korpi Road, and Highway 600 and Tait Road, Township of Chapple

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is to rezone the subject lands from Rural (RU) to Mineral Mining Holding Zone MM(H). The effect of the Zoning By-law Amendment is to permit the development of a new open pit and underground gold mine on the subject lands to produce doré bars (semi-pure alloy of gold and silver) for sale. The Holding (H) provision will ensure that the Environmental Assessment is approved by the Minister prior to the MM Zone taking effect. The current Township of Chapple Official Plan sets the framework for the process that allows the zoning to be put in place for the gold mine.

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to, the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment.

IF A PERSON or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Chapple before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Township of Chapple to the Ontario Municipal Board.

NO PERSON or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal unless, before the by-law is passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
