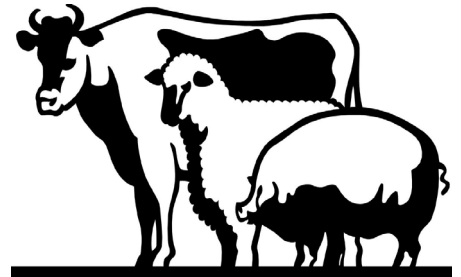

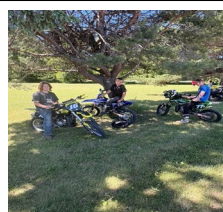

<p>BURN PERMITS Are to be purchased online https://chapple.burnpermits.com/ Permits are needed from January 1st to December 31st</p> 	<p>Chief Building Official Information: All decks require building Permits. Some property owners have incorrect information about the requirements for Building Permits relating to decks. For example: “Deck is not attached to house” – Building Permit <u>is</u> required. “I’m replacing - repairing an existing deck” - Building Permit <u>is</u> required. “My deck is less than 24” above the ground” - Building Permit <u>is</u> required. “My deck is only a small landing and stairs at my door” - Building Permit <u>is</u> required. “I’m adding a new railing/stairway/extension/etc. to my deck” - Building Permit <u>is</u> required. <i>If you are planning to build or change a deck, check with the Building Official whether you need a permit.</i> <i>Don’t rely on others for this information.</i></p>	<p>Fitness Centre Memberships are available at the Municipal Office</p> <p>Single/yr.: \$100 plus \$20/Fob Single/Mth.: \$40 plus \$20/Fob Single/6 Mth.: \$60 plus \$20/Fob Family: \$150/year plus \$20/Fob</p> <p>* \$25 per Fob to replace.
